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## Prosecco & Champagne

<b>PROSECCO, BEL CANTO Veneto, Italy</b>		<b>£21.00</b>
	20cl Bottle	<b>£7.50</b>
Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.		

<b>NORTHUMBERLAND GOLF CLUB HOUSE CHAMPAGNE Champagne, France</b>		<b>£35.00</b>
A light and fruity Champagne with fine bubbles and subtle overtones of apples and pears.		

<b>MOËT &amp; CHANDON ROSÉ Champagne, France</b>		<b>£65.00</b>
Pink copper hues and a lively expressive aroma, this is an elegant zesty rose wine with notes of wild strawberry.		

## Rosé Wine

<b>ROSÉ, LE BOIS DES VIOLETTES Pays d’Oc, France</b>		<b>£17.00</b>
	125ml Glass	<b>£3.50</b>

	250ml Glass	<b>£6.20</b>
Fresh and crisp, with very subtle strawberry fruit and a refreshing dryness. The splash of muscat adds a dash of juicy grapeyness.		

## Port

<b>LATE BOTTLED VINTAGE PORT Oporto, Portugal</b>	50ml	<b>£3.20</b>
Deep ruby red colour, black morello cherry on the nose, great vibrancy and wonderful freshness of fruit. On the palate, cassis, plums and blackberry combine harmoniously with the well-integrated tannins. Long, elegant finish.		

## White Wine

<b>PINOT GRIGIO, CRESCENDO Terre di Chieti, Italy</b>		<b>£17.00</b>

A clean and elegant wine with real finesse. Showing balanced flavours of pear, stone fruit and lime with refreshing acidity.		

<b>SAUVIGNON BLANC, VIÑA CARRASCO Central Valley, Chile</b>		<b>£17.00</b>

Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon. A riper hint of pineapple and tropical fruit on the palate, with mouth-watering acidity.		

<b>VIOGNIER RESERVA, RISCOS Colchagua Costa, Chile</b>		<b>£19.00</b>
A soft, rounded wine with floral aromas and flavours of ripe peach and apricot.		

<b>ALBARIÑO, EL CANTE Rias Baixas, Spain</b>		<b>£23.00</b>
A fresh and youthful wine with a zesty and well defined citrus backbone. Flavours of nectarine, apricot and peach add body and ripeness.		

<b>SAUVIGNON BLANC, FERNLANDS Marlborough, New Zealand</b>		<b>£25.00</b>
Wonderful balance between tropical and herbaceous flavours. Mango, passionfruit and pink grapefruit mingle perfectly with grassy and gooseberry notes.		

<b>MÂCON-LUGNY, LOUIS LATOUR Burgundy, France</b>		<b>£26.00</b>
A classic Burgundy from one of the region’s most respected producers. Aromas of fresh apples, lemon curd and toasted citrus fruits with a palate of fresh and crisp green apple acidity, peachy fruit and a rich texture.		

<b>CHARDONNAY, CLOUDY BAY Marlborough, New Zealand</b>		<b>£40.00</b>
A complex nose that ranges from figs and lemon butter to more savoury elements of fresh hay and hints of butterscotch. The palate is substantial and rounded with toasty complexity and a long finish.		

## Red Wine

<b>MERLOT, VIÑA CARRASCO Central Valley, Chile</b>		<b>£17.00</b>

Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, with faint hints of tomato leaf and sage. The palate has a full and jammy feel with soft, mature tannins and a rounded, easy style.		

<b>RIOJA CRIANZA, CUNE Rioja, Spain</b>		<b>£20.00</b>

A lively cherry-red appearance leading to a nose of light summer fruits. This wine has undergone a period of one year in oak giving beautiful hints of vanilla amongst fruity cherry notes.		

<b>CARIGNAN, BARON DE BAUSSAC Pays d’Oc, France</b>		<b>£21.00</b>
Deep and inky in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from oak ageing. Bold, meaty tannins provide satisfying texture and length.		

<b>ROSSO PUGLIA APPASSIMENTO, APERICENA Puglia, Italy</b>		<b>£22.00</b>
Intense red in colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. Full-bodied, it is supple and well balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.		

<b>BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR, CHÂTEAU MÉAUME Bordeaux, France</b>		<b>£23.00</b>
A nose of fruitcake, spice and ripe, plummy fruit. Soft and rich on the palate, with blackcurrants, plum, and smoky cedarwood.		

<b>CÔTES DU RHÔNE, E. GUIGAL Rhone, France</b>		<b>£26.00</b>
A full-bodied wine with a robust core of dark fruit, and savoury peppery notes. Guigal use a higher proportion of Syrah in their blend than typical Southern Rhone wines, adding body, spice, and complexity.		

<b>THE CHOCOLATE BLOCK, BOEKENHOUTSKLOOF Rhone, France</b>		<b>£40.00</b>
An earthy, rustic nose gives up aromas of leather, earth and spices over a backdrop of blackcurrant and ripe raspberry fruit. Harmonious and powerful on the palate, with a cocoa and pepper complexity.
