LATE BOTTLED VINTAGE PORT 50ml £3.20 Oporto, Portugal

Deep ruby red colour, black morello cherry on the nose, great vibrancy and wonderful freshness of fruit. On the palate, cassis, plums and blackberry combine harmoniously with the well-integrated tannins. Long, elegant finish.

PINOT GRIGIO, CRESCENDO Terre di Chieti, Italy A clean and elegant wine with real finesse. Showing balanced flavours of pear, stone fruit and lime with refreshing acidity. £17.00 £3.50 £4.70 £50ml Glass £6.20

SAUVIGNON BLANC, VIÑA CARRASCO Central Valley, Chile Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon. £17.00 £3.50 £4.70

Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon. A riper hint of pineapple and tropical fruit on the palate, with mouth-watering acidity.

VIOGNIER RESERVA, RISCOS Colchagua Costa, Chile £19.00

A soft, rounded wine with floral aromas and flavours of ripe peach and apricot.

ALBARIÑO, EL CANTE £23.00 Rias Baixas, Spain

A fresh and youthful wine with a zesty and well defined citrus backbone. Flavours of nectarine, apricot and peach add body and ripeness.

SAUVIGNON BLANC, FERNLANDS Marlborough, New Zealand £25.00

Wonderful balance between tropical and herbaceous flavours. Mango, passionfruit and pink grapefruit mingle perfectly with grassy and gooseberry notes.

MÂCON-LUGNY, LOUIS LATOUR Burgundy, France

A classic Burgundy from one of the region's most respected producers. Aromas of fresh apples, lemon curd and toasted citrus fruits with a palate of fresh and crisp green apple acidity, peachy fruit and a rich texture.

CHARDONNAY, CLOUDY BAY Marlborough, New Zealand £40.00

A complex nose that ranges from figs and lemon butter to more savoury elements of fresh hay and hints of butterscotch. The palate is substantial and rounded with toasty complexity and a long finish.

Red Wine

MERLOT, VIÑA CARRASCO	£17.00
Central Valley, Chile	125ml Glass £3.50
Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, with faint hints of	175ml Glass £4.70

RIOJA CRIANZA, CUNE	£	20.00
Rioja, Spain	125ml Glass	£4.20
A lively cherry-red appearance leading to a nose of light summer	175ml Glass	£5.20
fruits. This wine has undergone a period of one year in oak	250ml Glass	£7.30
giving beautiful hints of vanilla amongst fruity cherry notes.		

CARIGNAN, BARON DE BAUSSAC Pays d'Oc, France

Deep and inky in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from oak ageing. Bold, meaty tannins provide satisfying texture and length.

ROSSO PUGLIA APPASSIMENTO, APERICENA Puglia, Italy £22.00

Intense red in colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. Full-bodied, it is supple and well balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.

BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR, CHÂTEAU MÉAUME £23.00 Bordeaux, France

A nose of fruitcake, spice and ripe, plummy fruit. Soft and rich on the palate, with blackcurrants, plum, and smoky cedarwood.

CÔTES DU RHÔNE, E. GUIGAL £26.00 Rhone, France

A full-bodied wine with a robust core of dark fruit, and savoury peppery notes. Guigal use a higher proportion of Syrah in their blend than typical Southern Rhone wines, adding body, spice, and complexity.

THE CHOCOLATE BLOCK, BOEKENHOUTSKLOOF £40.00 Rhone, France

An earthy, rustic nose gives up aromas of leather, earth and spices over a backdrop of blackcurrant and ripe raspberry fruit. Harmonious and powerful on the palate, with a cocoa and pepper complexity.
